

Scope

The Quantitative InfraredThermography (QIRT) conference is an international forum, which brings together specialists from industry and academia, who share an active interest in the latest developments of instrumentation and experimental practices related to infrared thermography.

Following the conferences in Paris (1992), Sorrento (1994), Stuttgart (1996), Lodtz (1998), Reims (2000) and Dubrovnik (2002), the seventh Quantitative Infrared Thermography conference, QIRT'2004, will take place on July 5-8, 2004 at the von Karman Institute for Fluid Dynamics in Rhode Saint Genèse, Belgium.

The International Conference QIRT'2004 will emphasise the following topics:

- State-of-the-art and evolution in the field of infrared scanners and imaging systems allowing quantitative measurements, and related data acquisition and storing systems.
- Calibration and characterization of infrared cameras (mono and multidetector systems).
- Related problems like certification, standardization, emissivity determination, absorption in media, spurious radiations, three dimensionality of observed objects.
- Infrared effects induced e.g. by electromagnetic or elastic fields.
- Application of infrared thermography to radiometry, thermometry, and thermal parameters identification, in all fields: fluid mechanics, material sciences, structures and material non destructive evaluations, medicine and biomedical science, remote sensing, environment, industrial processes...

Pre-conference course

Preceding the conference, the following courses will be organised: A-Basic Thermography; B-Array Detector Systems; C-Application to Fluids; D-Application to Solids.

Each of these Courses involves four hours of lectures. The Courses are scheduled on Monday July 5, 2004. The tuition is $150 \in$ per course including tutorial and lunch. Attendants at two courses pay $250 \in$.

- Indicate your preference for "Oral Presentation" or "Poster Presentation."

The authors will be notified by **January 15, 2004** about the acceptance of their papers and posters.

FULL LENGTH PAPERS

Authors are invited to submit the final form of the papers for oral presentation (6 pages) and the written versions of poster presentation (6 pages) to the conference secretary by **April 30, 2004**.

The papers must be written and presented in English, which is the official language of the conference, and written according to the Instructions for Authors, which will be available later on the QIRT'2004 web site. Authors are requested to provide only electronic version of their camera-ready papers as *.doc or *.pdf either on cd-rom or as e-mail attached file to girt2004@vki.ac.be.

All the contributions will be distributed in a black and white copy at the conference.

All the papers delivered on April 30, 2004 will be reviewed for publication in the new **International Journal of QIRT**, to be published by Hermes-Lavoisier, the first issue of which is scheduled in 2004. Criteria for acceptance are: technical and scientific merit, paper written according to Instruction for Authors, drawing clean and clear, relevant literature and previous work properly quoted, correct grammar and English style. All the participants to QIRT'2004 will get a free subscription to the Journal of QIRT for two years (4 issues).

ORAL PRESENTATION
